Most of the meeting was devoted to the sea level rise SLR and storm surge report. Paul Kirshen is to invite Steve Gill of NOAA ([stephen.gill@noaa.gov](mailto:stephen.gill@noaa.gov)), as of 2012, chief scientist with the NOS Center for Operational Oceanographic Products and Services (CO-OPS) in Silver Spring, Md. This was done on March 15.

Additional Contents for SLR and Surge Report.

In the Feb 3 meeting the Panel suggested to following for the report contents:

- physical basis
- observations
- paleo climate
- basis of projections
- regional and local effects

Here we also suggested the SLR section contain local, regional, global impacts.

The surge section may contain information on storms that have struck NH and impacts on tides.

The report should also contain information on additional needs.

The meeting ended with scheduling another meeting in March.
